## Best Practices Poster Presentation and Award at the IACBE ACAM 2024

### SUBMISSIONS DUE MARCH 15<sup>th</sup>

With the goal of sharing effective quality enhancement initiatives and fostering a community of continuous improvement, Peregrine Global Services is sponsoring a Best Practices poster session in conjunction with the IACBE ACAM.

The accepted presenters for the poster session will compete for the **Best Practices Award** that best demonstrates excellence in continuous improvement by implementing best practice(s) into their institution's or program's assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiatives.

### Eligibility

Proposals for the **Best Practices Poster Session** will include a well-written, carefully edited, and organized description of the poster presentation, including a brief abstract, a detailed description of the methods used for measuring outcomes, conclusion(s) drawn from the assessment results, as well as recommendations based on the conclusion(s) and next steps for supporting the assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiatives.

Submitting a proposal implies that the presenter(s) will register for the conference. The poster session will be included in the conference agenda. The date and time of the poster session at the conference is to be determined.

By submitting your Best Practices Poster to Peregrine Global Services, you expressively give Peregrine Global Services permission to use the information in outreach and marketing materials and content. In addition, you may be invited to co-write articles or appear as a guest presenter regarding the information submitted as part of the Best Practices Poster Award and in collaboration with Peregrine Global Services.

### Best Practices Poster Session

The recipient of the **Best Practices Award** will be recognized at the IACBE ACAM 2024 and will receive an award of \$500 in the recipient's name to a foundation or nonprofit of choice for the poster presentation that best represents the following:

1. method used for supporting the institution's or program's assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiative
2. the institution's or program's assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiative process
3. results collected
4. the conclusion(s) drawn from the results
5. the recommendations based on the conclusion(s) and next steps for supporting the assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiative

## Poster Preparation

- Posters are to be a maximum of 42" wide by 42" tall.
- Format the poster in APA format.
- Posters should be printed on standard or heavyweight paper and may be laminated or vinyl.
- Posters are single, free-standing research presentations. Poster presentations require the active participation of the primary presenter(s). The material should be explained briefly, and the poster should include supporting graphic and/or visual information. The poster presentation allows for high levels of interaction and discussion.

## Proposal Submission Guidelines

Please include the following information with submission of **Best Practices Award** poster proposal.

1. Provide the individual's name, institution, and complete contact information.

  - For each additional speaker, provide the following information:
    - First & Last Name
    - Title

2. A poster title that accurately reflects the presentation.
3. Abstract of the poster presentation that provides a clear and concise description of the poster, up to 150 words.
4. Description of the poster presentation, up to 1,000 words, including the following:
  - Detailed, well-written, carefully edited, and organized description of the methods used for continuous improvement.
  - Conclusion(s) drawn from the results
  - Recommendations based on the conclusion(s) and next steps for supporting your assurance of learning activities or quality enhancement initiatives
5. Proposals must be submitted at: <https://peregrineglobal.com/events/higher-education/best-practices-poster-session/>. Only proposals submitted electronically at the designated webpage will be accepted.
6. Proposals must be submitted to the portal by midnight Mountain time on March 15<sup>th</sup>.
7. The Primary Speaker will be notified by March 18<sup>th</sup> regarding proposals that have been accepted for presentation at the poster session.
