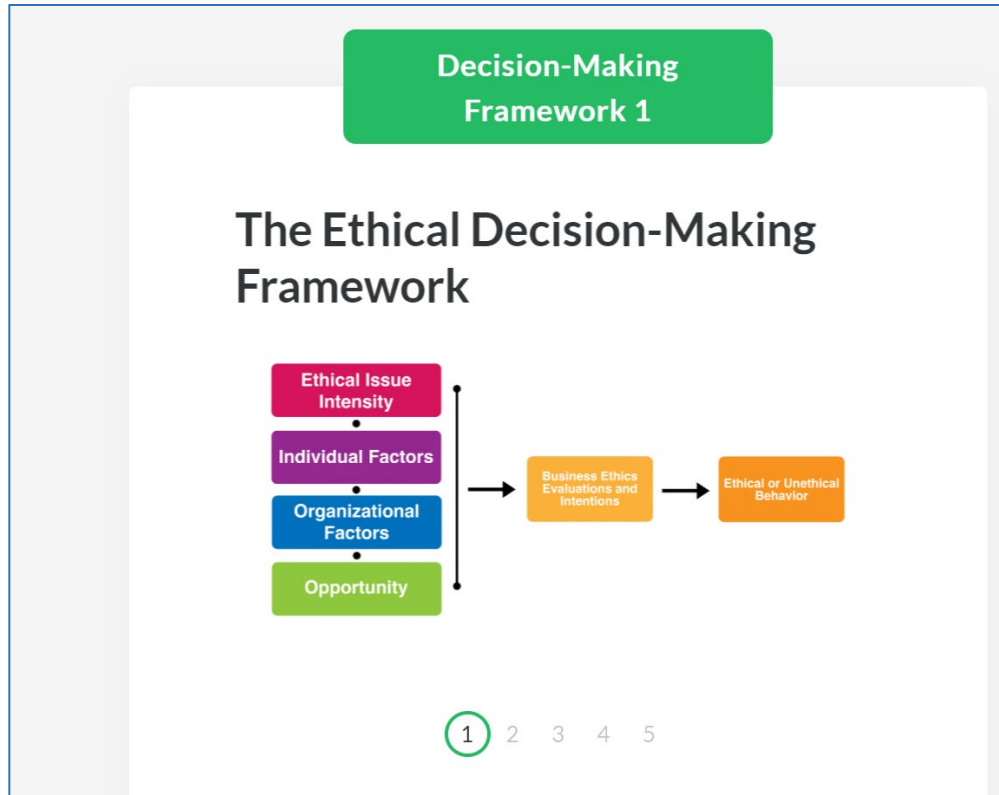
This module is appropriate for learners who have or will have workplace responsibilities that hinge on ethics and ethical conduct.
