
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
Learning Management System (LMS) Write & Cite Access

Many colleges and universities choose to integrate Write & Cite into the course shell of their Learning Management System (LMS). There are several different types of LMS systems including but not limited to: Blackboard, BlueQuill, Canvas, D2L, eCollege, Jenzebar, Moodle, Sakai, and more. How you gain access to your assignments will vary for all universities. Below is a general guideline as to how you might gain access to your particular LMS.

- 1. Please follow the instructions provided by your instructor or course syllabus. The Write & Cite link will be embedded into one of your weekly assignments. You will need to locate the week that the link has been placed.
- 2. Please click the access link that is included in the assignment.
- 3. You will be prompted to confirm your name, student ID, program, as well as other possible identifiers that your school may choose.
- 4. Once you have filled out the required fields, please click **Confirm** to start.



All Learning Management Systems are different. Please refer to your course instructor or course syllabus to locate where the exam has been placed within your course shell.




Launch the module by clicking "Please click here to launch your course/exam. You will read through a series of acknowledgment screens and check each box once you have read the information. You will then be ready to begin the module.

What is the overall structure and time constraints of the Write & Cite: Academic Writing Readiness Course?

- ❖ There are 8 total modules that make up the Write & Cite course.
- ❖ Each module will provide 3-5 learning sections, though a couple modules will only consist of one section.
- The courses will teach APA, MLA, or CMS documentation styles depending on the Write & Cite version that your institution is requiring you to take. The remaining modules will provide instruction regarding word choices, tone, papers organization, literature-based research, and techniques to avoid plagiarism.
- ❖ Each course starts with a twenty-question pre-test which must be completed prior to starting the instructional material.
- ❖ Each section will conclude with a 5-question quiz. To advance to the next section, you must answer 3 questions correctly. If after the 5-question quiz, you do not answer 3 questions correctly, you will need to redo the prior section.
- The courses will conclude with a 50-question competency exam with questions randomly drawn from the entire course. The competency exam does offer a retake option, however only the last score is recorded and your first score will not be retrievable.


The first screen you will see is the Write & Cite Course Overview. This page introduces the Write & Cite course. On this screen, you will notice:

You can open and close the Write & Cite menu at any time by clicking the icon on the top left corner of the course screen.






Pre-test

- If you do not answer three questions correctly on the first, you will need to retake the quiz, prior to advancing.






Competency Exam
